

The Bailiffs Act, 1960-1961

Bond No.:

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that we, (hereinafter called the Principal) as Principal, and _____ (hereinafter called the Surety) as Surety are held and firmly bound unto Her Majesty in right of Ontario (hereinafter called the Obligee) in the sum of ----- 00/100 Dollars (\$00) lawful money of Canada, to be paid unto the Obligee, his/her successors and assigns, for which payment well and truly to be made, I, the said bind myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns, and we, the said _____ bind ourselves, our successors and assigns jointly and firmly by these presents.

1. This bond may be cancelled by the Surety by giving to the Registrar of Collection Agencies at least two months' notice in writing of intention to cancel and it shall be deemed to be cancelled on the date stated in the notice which date shall be not less than two months after receipt of the notice by the Registrar.
2. For the purposes of every act or omission occurring during the period in which this bond is in force, this bond shall continue in force and shall remain on deposit for a period of two years after the revocation of the appointment of the Principal, as bailiff, or the cancellation of the bond, whichever occurs first.

NOW THE CONDITION of the above obligation is such that if the obligation does not by reason of any act, matter or thing at any time hereafter become or be forfeit under the Act, then the obligation shall be void, but otherwise shall be and remain in full force and effect.
