KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that we , (hereinafter called the Principal), and _____, (hereinafter called the Surety), are held and firmly bound unto the Chief Electrical Inspector for the YUKON TERRITORY, (hereinafter called the Obligee), in the penal sum of ----- 00/100 Dollars (\$.00), lawful money of Canada, to be paid to the Obligee or his successor in office or his or their assigns, for which payment well and truly to be made we bind ourselves, our successors and assigns firmly by these presents.

WHEREAS the Principal, being the Contractor within the meaning of the Electrical Protection Ordinance is required to furnish and maintain security in the sum of 00/100 Dollars (\$.00), lawful money of Canada, pursuant to the Electrical Protection Act by way of a Bond of an insurer.

NOW, therefore, the condition of the above-written obligation is such that if the Principal shall comply with the provisions of the Electrical Protection Act during the term of any electrical contractor's license held by him under the said Act, then this obligation shall be void, otherwise this obligation shall be and remain in full force and effect.

THE Surety shall pay any and all claims under this bond within sixty days after proof of the claim shall have been furnished to the Surety.

PROVIDED that if the Surety shall at any time wish to terminate the obligation hereby undertaken the Surety shall give 30 days notice in writing to the Obligee and to the Principal of its desire to terminate the obligation hereby undertaken and then, all liability on the part of the Surety hereunder shall cease and determine so far as concerns any acts of the Principal subsequent to the termination of the Surety's obligation hereby undertaken.
